A Ministry Decision Before Us

Dear Family of Faith,

Our church's radio ministry, 94.3 FM The Bridge, needs regular support to stay on the air. We need approximately \$850 annually to pay for music licenses, and additional funding for equipment maintenance and ongoing operational costs. At present, our **Emergency Alert System** (EAS) is non-functional. Without EAS compliance, we risk facing **FCC fines**.

Jeff Smith, our station manager, is researching the costs to **repair or replace the EAS** hardware and update its firmware. This could cost several thousand dollars, or it could be much cheaper, but this is currently unknown.

Since 2022, The Bridge has been sustained by a generous one-time gift from another Lutheran station that closed. That funding is nearly gone, and the members who previously had gotten underwriting (a form of non-profit sponsorship) for KRRC are no longer able to do so. With the EAS needing repair, it's time for us to make a decision together as a congregation.

We are considering three options:

Option 1: Keep The Bridge on FM

- Stay on the air as a low-power FM station
- Pastor Laws and member(s) will seek **underwriting or donor support** for:
 - Annual operating costs
 - o EAS updates and repairs
 - A modest payment for Jeff Smith's ongoing work (approx. 5-7 hours a week).

Option 2: Switch to Online Streaming Only

- Move The Bridge to a **streaming-only format**
- Still need **underwriting** for:
 - Streaming licenses
 - o Payment for Jeff Smith's continued labor
- No EAS repairs required

Option 3: Close The Bridge

- Thank God for the years of faithful broadcasting
- Use remaining funds to support another Lutheran station or media ministry
- Continue using our studio for podcasts and audiobook projects
