Circuit Forum (October 7th, 2025) Report

- Led by the Rev. Jim Markus (Trinity Lutheran Church in Cottage Grove, Emeritus Pastor and Circuit Visitor for Circuit 2). Pastor Laws and Charlie Smith attended as Faith's representatives.
- **†** Circuit Forums occur once a triennium to elect a pastoral & lay elector to represent our Circuit's congregations to Synod Convention.
- Circuits 1 & 2 are a joint circuit for Synod Convention. A Circuit must have between 7-20 congregations, with 1500-10,000 members combined. Our circuits need to be a joint circuit to qualify for an exemption. We have a tradition of trading each triennium, with one Circuit sending a pastoral delegate, and the other a lay delegate. This practice was affirmed by the electors prior to the vote.

Christian Education

- Kids are using CPH's "Enduring Faith" curriculum. The next unit of curriculum will be purchased for Winter quarter.
- Adults are studying Luther's Large Catechism. Ten Commandments should be finished during Advent.
- Request for 2026 Budget: Increase of Education money from \$250 to \$500, in order to allow for purchase of copies of books for classes, boards, etc. as needed.

Elders

- Engaging in study on the doctrine of the Church, the Ministry, and Church Polity.

KRRC

- † At last Voter's Assembly, an item was withdrawn concerning KRRC. Money had been found in a few accounts to keep KRRC running, likely will allow us to pay our bills for 2026, but still running low.
- Still working on Emergency Alert System. Jeff hasn't heard back from the engineer he spoke to.
- Jeff is looking into dropping the news (\$100/month) and a few other cost-saving measures.
- No volunteers for underwriting. KRRC still needs underwriting to continue operation. If we do not have volunteers on this, we will need to close the station.
